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The KSCB Child Sexual Exploitation Framework

has been produced for professionals working with children who experience, or at risk of, sexual exploitation. Its aim is to provide and promote a clear and consistent response to concerns about CSE in Knowlsey.

This framework meets the KSCB priority area 3 which is "children and young people in Knowsley are safeguarded from exploitation including sexual exploitation".

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Knowsley Safeguarding Children board is committed to ensuring that all children who are at risk or victims of CSE are:- treated as a child who is a victim of abuse

 provided with a prompt response to protect and promte their welfare
provided with joint multi agency working to prevent abuse and provide exit strategeis to young people and to investigate and contribute to prosecution of those who exploit children in this way.

The Framework equips frontline practitioners with up to date information regarding CSE including signs and indicators, vulnerabilities, models of CSE, confidentiality, information and intelligence sharing and the legal framework. It also sets out agency roles in responding to CSE.

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This Framework has been overseen and subject to consultation from the multi agency KSCB CSE and Missing Children Sub Group and will initially be reviewed after 6 months and then on an annual basis to ensure that any changes or updates are reflected in the document.
