

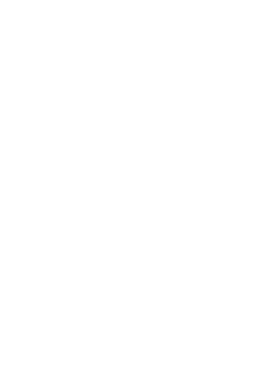


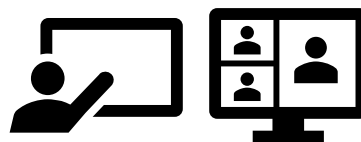
Knowsley Safeguarding Children Partnership Training Programme 2023 – 24

Knowsley Safeguarding Children Partnership provides a programme of training for all professionals and volunteers working with families and children across Knowsley. All our training courses are free to access and cover a range of subjects, from comprehensive safeguarding training to specialist topics. We also host 60 Minute Briefings and publish 7 Minute Briefings to keep the partnership informed of current safeguarding themes and initiatives.

Individuals should identify their own training needs and which courses are appropriate for them through supervision and discussions with their organisation's safeguarding representatives, based upon their job roles and contact with families and children. This multi-agency training programme is designed to supplement safeguarding training within organisations and to address the importance of practitioners working effectively and collaboratively. We aim to assist professionals to develop the knowledge, skills and attitudes that they need to contribute positively to multi-agency working and to achieve better outcomes for children and young people.
